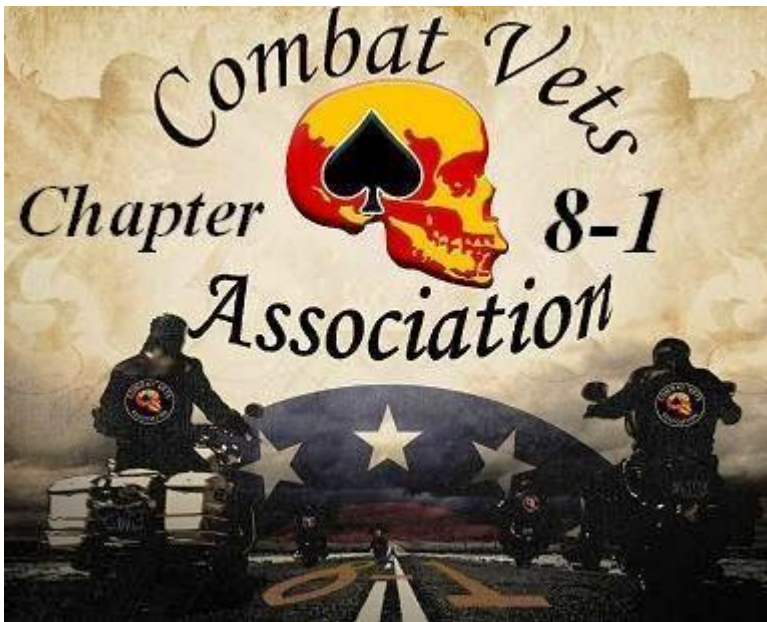

In May of 2001 the CVMA adopted the CVMA/VFW patch. On December 15, 2002 it was voted the CVMA would wear a combination of the CVMA background and the old skull logo as a one-piece patch.

On 1 July 2006 Chapter 8 became a full Chapter in Hawaii and adopted a patch to represent the area, which services Oahu, Maui, Kauai, Molokai, and Lanai. The skull represents our ties to Combat Veterans Motorcycle Association. The national and state flag represent our commitment to the community we service and the nation we represent.

State Bills currently under consideration

SB2992_SSCR2508 – The purpose of this measure is to improve motorcycle safety by permanently authorizing the DOT under certain conditions to designate shoulders upon which the DOT may authorize the driving of motorcycles. As of 12 Feb 2020
